


# The Shed

The Shed is a place for people to come and help look after Durlston Country Park.




It is open every:


- Monday at 10am




until 3pm

You can do lots of different things, including woodworking, gardening, and arts & crafts.



# Arrival

On arrival you will be greeted by a Ranger or Sheddie. These are the people who run the activities at the Shed and are there to help you.



Rangers wear green tops, and Sheddies have name badges. Speak to them if you have any questions or feel uncomfortable.



You may need to borrow some safety equipment such as gloves, boots or safety glasses.



Ask a Ranger or Sheddie if you would like to borrow a pair of ear defenders.




# Access

This is the main front door. It is wheelchair accessible and leads to the kitchen.

It is heavy to push open, so please knock and someone will open it for you.



The Shed has four rooms and an outdoor patio.



The sliding doors between the patio and workshop are easy to open and always unlocked.



# Inside

## Kitchen

The kitchen has seats to sit and relax and space to eat your lunch

It can get busy at times with people talking, making tea, and opening or closing the door.



## Workshop

The workshop is louder space with people using tools like saws, hammers, and drills.

The Rangers and Sheddies will show you how to do the activities.



# Outside

Outside there are gardening and woodworking areas.

It is quieter outside so tell a Ranger or Sheddie if you would prefer to work here.

Sometimes new people visit and may speak to you. Tell them to speak to a Ranger or Sheddie if you are not sure what to say.

Sometimes people visit the Shed with their pet dogs.



# Toilet

The toilet is located in the green building next to the Shed.



After you use the toilet you put wood shavings in the toilet instead of using a flush.




Easy to read instructions can be found on the wall inside.
